**Bedwyn Footpaths Group Monthly Walk – Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2016**

From **The Village Hall car park** Route is approx 3.75 miles.

This walk eventually leads to a beautiful path up through the woods at Webbs Gully, behind Folly Farm.

From the village hall our group of 12 walkers briefly entered Bedwyn Brail before emerging to cross the road towards Folly Farm. The section of path here, from the Brail to the road, was cleared twice by our working parties last year and although it has overgrown again it is nothing like at bad as it was last year! Behind Folly Farm we'll take the bridleway that runs through Webbs Gully. It can be wet at times but when we walked it was thankfully dry. We then turned back along the bridleway close to Burrige Heath Farm, dropping down the hill to Jockey Green. We returned to the village hall via Galley Lane and the recently fenced path by the cricket pitch.

Along the way we used paths in Little Bedwyn and Shalbourne parishes but these all link with our own parish's network to make a lovely circular walk.

There are some inclines and a little rough ground through parts of the woods but most of the route is fairly easy walking with no stiles. This walk has a little of everything; quiet woodland paths, shady tracks, grassland flowers and views across the fields.
