**Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> Feb, from Village Hall 4.5 miles Little Bedwyn and Burridge Heath**

15 walkers set off to Little Bedwyn along the bridgeway and the track to Parlow Bottom. Then turned up the hill to take a footpath through fields and across a horse training track to meet the road. After a short stretch back along the road we picked up the Burridge Heath tracks down to Jockey Green, then along Galley Lane back to the village hall.

Big skies on this walk, the views are open across the fields and on the recce we saw deer on the field boundaries. The flocks of different breeds of sheep in the fields that we passed through stopped grazing and came over to watch us go by with interest.

There are 3 stiles along the way although there is a short diversion you can take around 2 of these if necessary. The inclines are steady but not steep. The surface is muddy along the bridgeway and Galley Lane but otherwise good tracks or grass.

***Dogs on leads under close control at all times please, the sheep may be nearby.***
