

Jan 2017 Little Bedwyn, Chisbury Chapel

Bedwyn Footpaths Group monthly walk – 22nd Jan

16 walkers came on this month's walk, a circular route of just under 5 miles from The Cross Keys along the towpath then uphill on the road from Little Bedwyn to briefly visit the pretty thatched 13th century chapel of St Martins in Chisbury. We came back along the village lanes and down through the woods and fields

There is a long steady incline up to the chapel, a long section on the lane through Chisbury and one stile to negotiate. The flight of steps over the footbridge at Little Bedwyn can be avoided if necessary by using the road instead.
