

**Sat 21<sup>st</sup> July, Guided 1.5 mile walk. Bedwyn Brail,**

Richard Charles, custodian of the Brails, kindly took our group on a guided tour of the Brails again this year and is also provided refreshments for the group too!

We invited residents, friends and family with limited mobility to join us so it was only a short walk of a little over half a mile into the Brails along a made-up track and we returned along the same route. A group of 30 people came on this walk, with mobility scooters, frames and sticks and were accompanied by the more able members of the group.

Richard is extremely knowledgeable on the flora and fauna of the area, its conservation and he is also actively involved in the recent archaeological works seeking to uncover the history of this special area.

The track is suitable for certain mobility scooters and can be accessed from the private farmyard with permission of the owner.
