Bedwyn Footpaths Group Monthly Walk – Sunday June 21<sup>st</sup>

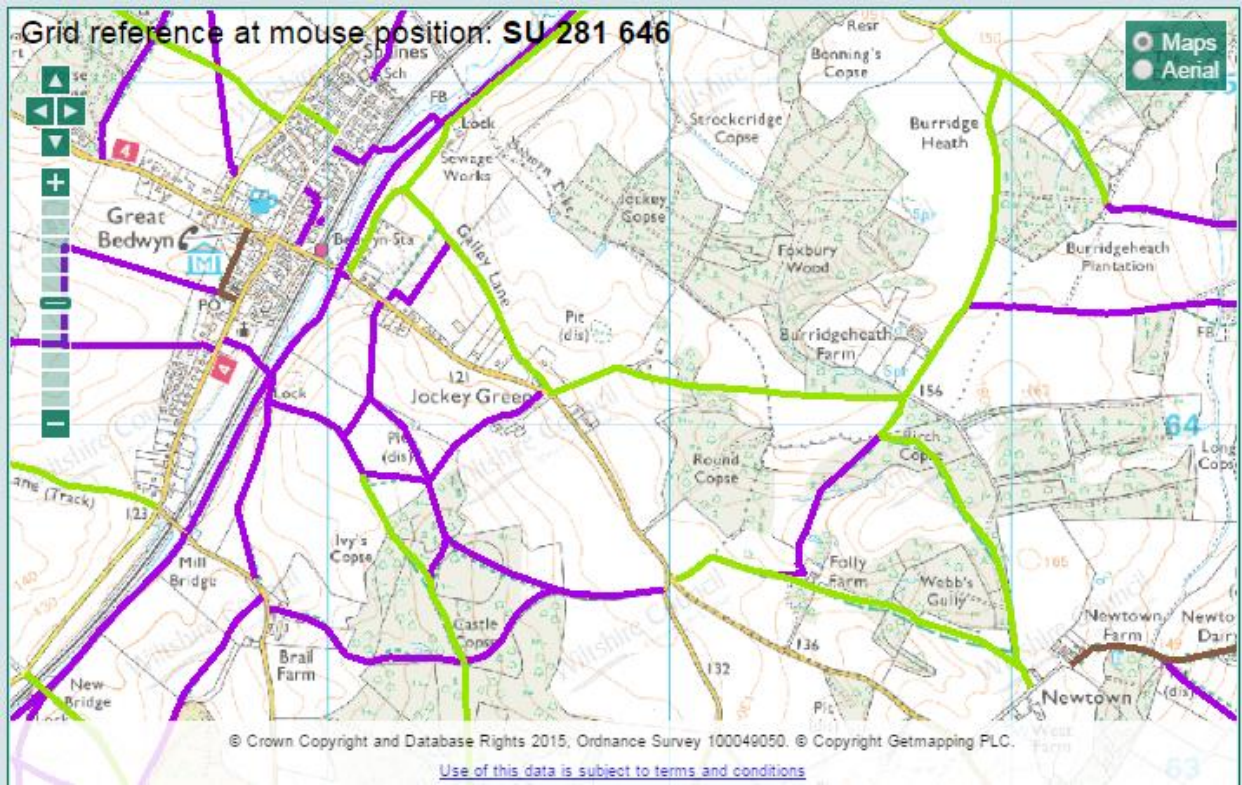
From Village Hall. Approx 3 ¾ miles.

This walk took us out along Path No 50, called Galley Lane. This is a beautiful sunken tree-lined track and a personal favourite of Judy's! Then up the hill from Jockey Green, skirting the parish boundaries of Little Bedwyn and Shalbourne (paths LBED 3 & 21 & SHAL 4) and down to Folly Farm along a little-used route through isolated pastureland. After crossing the road we returned along the edge of The Brail (path No 6), back down to Jockey Green, along Galley Lane and left to path No 4 beside the cricket pitch, back to finish at the village hall.

Tread carefully through an isolated meadow where Common Spotted Orchids maybe in flower iin summer.
