Bedwyn Footpaths Group Monthly Walk – Sunday 19th June 2016

Pay and display parking at **Crofton Beam Engines car park** Route is approx 3 miles.

Our walk started at Crofton. 19 of us walked about a mile along the towpath before heading up towards Tottenham deer park boundary where sadly this path comes to an abrupt halt, leaving us no choice but to return by the same route. Bedwyn parish path GBED 35 is on Wiltshire's definitive rights of way map and this dead-end bridleway illustrates some of the anomalies of the network.

There are no stiles to tackle but there's a steady incline leading up away from the canal - I think it's worth it for the view though!

If anyone would like to extend the they could choose to continue along the towpath to The Bruce tunnel (which would add 1.5 miles to the overall distance) or walk up to see Wolfhall (an extra $\frac{3}{4}$ mile).

Crofton café has a seasonal café – The Enginman's rest. Check their website for opening times. The car park currently charges 50p for 2 hours
