

Mar 2017 Bedwyn Circular

Bedwyn Footpaths Group Monthly Walk – Sunday 19th Mar, from Cross Keys. 4 miles.

This month's walk route encircled the village and links many paths to make a healthy walk of just under 4 miles with some lovely views over the village. It doesn't stray far from Bedwyn centre so you'll have many opportunities to cut the walk short if you need to.

From the village centre 9 walkers headed east, crossed the railway and walked through the dog-hole field, along Galley Lane to Jockey Green. From there we crossed over to skirt the Brail and came down Costers Hill. Then we turned west through the field to link up with Hatchet Lane and along the paths north of the village until we came to the Chisbury aerial. From there it was downhill back to the village.

Please take great care at the railway crossing. Please keep dogs on leads at the crossing, through the fields, near sheep, lambs & wildlife

There are no stiles on the route, a few moderate inclines and a one fairly steep hill, walking down Costers Hill.
