We headed up to the Brails, entering Bedwyn Brail through the new kissing gate. From Castle Copse we turned down to Brail Farm and crossed the road to skirt Wilton Brail. Then we'll walked down to join the towpath to walk back to the start.

We passed the extensive clearance work going on at the northern end of Bedwyn Brail and saw some of the new bespoke way markers which the owner has erected in the Brails.

There are 2 stiles but the gate may be open alongside one of them. No steep inclines. Apart from when it snows this is a fairly leisurely walk.

Dogs on leads through the Brails please, to protect wildlife in the area.
