

Sunday 13th May, from The Pelican Inn, Froxfield. 4.6 miles

From The Pelican (please ask at the pub if you wish to park there – a good place for lunch after your walk!) our group of 14 walkers took the lane towards Jugg's Wood where you'll see many bluebells in spring. Then we continued along the track to the peaceful lane leading to Bagshot. Many spring flowers growing along the roadside banks. Primroses, violets, wood anemone and lady's smock were just some of the flowers that we saw on our walk. Rare breed sheep are kept in the fields bordering the road. At Stype Grange we left the road and walked through the adjoining parkland of mature trees and returned through Stype Wood along the Long Walk – a beautiful wide tree-lined grass driveway.
