Sunday 26th Nov, from The Square at 11.00 am. 5 miles Hatchet Lane, Stokke, Bedwyn Common

19 walkers took up the challenge of a 5 mile walk across fields, through woods and along lanes. From the village centre we headed up through the fields to the top of Hatchet Lane and walked the route of the proposed divert near Stokke (subsequently withdrawn). On towards St Katherine's – a much better surface since The Knapp plantings were used to improve it on the previous month. We then turned through Bedwyn Common, along a path that has received quite a lot of attention from our group in recent years to keep it accessible. We went along Chisbury Lane to take the stile into the field leading to Chisbury Woods, then down the hill to return to the village.

Parts of the route are often sticky and muddy in winter. The walk includes a section along a narrow road so take all usual care along the lane.
